



Emmanuel Anglican College Community Update: 11 December 2021

Dear students, staff and families,

NSW Health has confirmed that two students in Year 11 at Emmanuel Anglican College have tested positive for COVID-19. It is likely both students were positive on Wednesday 8 December when they attended school. Both students were asymptomatic while at school but have since developed mild symptoms.

All staff and students who attended the College on Wednesday 8 December are asked to self-isolate until you receive further advice. The College has commenced contact tracing and will be able to provide further information tomorrow (Sunday 12 December) about the extent of exposure and contact status of students and staff.

NSW Health requests that anyone who has any COVID-19 like symptoms, no matter how mild, such as a fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of smell/taste, muscle/joint pains, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting or extreme tiredness to be tested at one of the [COVID-19 testing clinics](#).

Our school site will be non-operational on Monday 13 December to allow time for contact tracing and cleaning. The Early Learning Centre will also be closed and Vacation Care will not go ahead.
