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College Uniform

The uniform of the College is seen as one of the public expressions of our values and our group identity. For this reason, all students are expected to conform to the standards expected and defined as part of their collective responsibility to one another.

Students are expected to be in correct uniform at all times.

PRIMARY UNIFORM

Girls - Formal

- College uniform dress *or* College polo shirt with navy skirt or shorts (navy gym pants/bike shorts may be worn under dress uniform in order to allow girls to enjoy the full range of physical activities whilst at play).
- College navy jumper or College navy jacket.
- College white socks with navy, jade and maroon stripe *or* navy tights when necessary (socks not to be worn over tights).
- All black polishable soft/hard leather lace-up school shoes. Must have a supportive heel. Stage 1 students (Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2) may have Velcro or buckle fastenings eg Mary Jane style shoe. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.
- College hat (wide brimmed or bucket hat).

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.

The College navy jacket is only available in size 8 and above.



Boys – Formal

- College polo shirt.
- Navy shorts or trousers.
- College navy jumper or College navy jacket.
- College short grey socks with navy, jade and maroon stripe.
- All black polishable soft/hard leather lace-up school shoes. Must have a heel (no flat sole).
Stage 1 students (Kindergarten, Year1 and Year 2) may have Velcro or buckle fastenings.
- College hat (wide brimmed or bucket hat).

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.

The College navy jacket is only available in size 8 and above.



Sports (Girls & Boys)

- College sports polo shirt.
- College navy sports shorts or College navy track pants.
- College navy jumper or College navy track jacket or College navy jacket.
- College white sports socks.
- Supportive sports shoes. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.
- College hat (wide brimmed or bucket hat).



SECONDARY (YEARS 7 - 10)

Girls - Formal

- College check blouse with navy tie.
- Navy skirt (two thirds of the thigh must be covered) *or* navy skort *or* navy formal shorts *or* navy trousers.
- College knitted jade jumper *or* College navy jacket (students may also wear a navy scarf during cooler weather).
- College white socks with navy, jade and maroon stripe, *or* navy tights when necessary (socks not to be worn over tights).
- Black polishable leather lace-up school shoes with heel up to 2cms, not black slip-on style shoes or buckled shoes. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.
- College hat (bucket hat, cap or wide brimmed).

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.



Boys - Formal

- College white shirt worn untucked except when wearing a jumper.
- Tailored navy shorts *or* navy trousers.
- Plain black leather belt.
- College knitted jade jumper *or* College navy jacket (students may also wear a navy scarf during cooler weather).
- College grey socks with navy, jade and maroon stripes.
- Black polishable leather lace-up school shoes, not black sports shoes or slip ons. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.
- College hat (bucket hat, cap or wide brimmed).

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.



SECONDARY (YEARS 11 – 12)

Girls - Formal

- College blazer – Compulsory for formal gatherings and during Terms 2 and 3.
- College white blouse and College tie.
- Navy skirt (two thirds of the thigh must be covered), navy skirt *or* navy formal shorts or navy trousers.
- College knitted jade jumper or College navy jacket (students may also wear a navy scarf during cooler weather).
- Year 12 jersey may be worn on Fridays and at College Carnivals.
- College white socks with navy, jade and maroon stripe *or* navy tights when necessary (socks not to be worn over tights).
- Black polishable leather lace-up school shoes with heel up to 2cms.
- College hat (bucket hat, cap or wide brimmed).
- College formal hat .

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.



Boys - Formal

- College blazer – Compulsory for formal gatherings and during Terms 2 and 3.
- College white shirt and College tie (shirt tucked in).
- Tailored navy shorts *or* navy trousers (trousers are compulsory for formal gatherings).
- Plain black leather belt.
- College knitted jade jumper (students may also wear a navy scarf during cooler weather).
- Year 12 jersey may be worn on Fridays and at College Carnivals.
- College grey socks with navy, jade and maroon stripes with both shorts and long trousers.
- Black polishable leather lace-up school shoes.
- College hat (bucket hat, cap or wide brimmed).
- College formal hat.

The College sports jacket is not to be worn with the dress uniform.



Secondary Sport (Girls & Boys)

- College House sports polo shirt.
- College navy sports shorts or College navy track pants.
- College navy track jacket or College navy jacket.
- College white sports socks.
- Supportive sports shoes. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.
- College hat (bucket hat, cap or wide brimmed).



SHOES

Primary

- **Girls** - Black polishable leather school shoes. Must have a heel (no flat sole).
- **Boys** - Black polishable leather school shoes. Must have a heel (no flat sole).
- **Sport** - Supportive sports shoes. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.

Secondary

- **Girls** - Black polishable leather lace-up or Mary Jane style shoes with heel up to 2cm (not black slip-on style shoes).
- **Boys** - Black polishable leather lace-up shoes with a heel (not black sports shoes).
- **Sport** - Supportive sports shoes. Skateboard and basketball shoes (hi-tops) are not acceptable.

GENERAL NOTES

College School Bag

Hair Colour and Style

- Hair is to be worn clean and brushed at all times. Hair touching the collar is to be tied back.
- Hair should not be shorter than a 'number two' clipper length.
- Hair should not be worn in dramatically differing lengths. This prohibits undercuts, mullets and other extreme cuts.
- Extremes in hair styles and /or cut patterns and/or unnatural colours are not permitted.
- Culturally appropriate hairstyles are allowed and must be tied back in accordance with the College safety and presentation expectations.
- Accessories in the hair such as beads, feathers are not allowed. Subdued coloured clips and pins are permitted. Ribbons, scrunchies and headbands must be in keeping with College colours.

Jewellery

- No decorative jewellery is to be worn to College. Watches may be worn, smart watches must be placed on airplane mode during school hours.
- Students with pierced ears are permitted to wear plain studs or simple small sleepers or hoops (no larger than a 5 cent piece or thicker than 2mm), without stones or adornment or other visual features. Two earrings per ear is acceptable and must be worn in the lower ear lobe.
- One simple silver or gold necklace (no thicker than 5mm). Shell, beaded or leather necklaces must not be worn.
- Rings, bracelets, anklets or other accessories are not permitted.

General Appearance and Presentation

- Coloured nail polish is not permitted.
- Cosmetics should be of natural appearance.
- Nails are to be clean and trimmed.
- Acrylic/gel nails shaped round or square oval of an appropriate length for sport maybe worn in the secondary school. Nails must be plain/natural colour with no nail art.
- Clear lip balm is allowed.
- Boys must be clean shaven.
